popcorn. On October 10th at 4:30 Carnegie Crystal Theater will be showing the movie **Hocus Pocus** and having pop and popcorn.

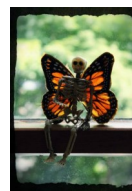
The 17th at 4:30 we will have **Super Hero training camp**. Come and see if you could be a Super Hero!

Adult activities for the month

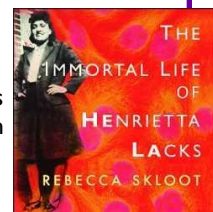
Join the staff on October 1st at 6:00 We will be making **hand-made clay bowls**. Cost is \$6 for materials. You must sign up to attend.
